


The quince (Turkish: Ayva) is a member of the Rosa family and a close relative of apples and pears. The wild fruit is thought to have originated in the regions of Anatolia, Greece and the Crimea. The most common varieties of quince in Turkey are the bardak, demir, ekmek, limon and esme. The bardak quince is most widely cultivated in the province of Kocaeli, and characterized by a downy peel, crisp juicy flesh and tangy flavor. Quinces are harvested in late September, tied in bunches, and stored in cellars for the winter. The demir ('iron') quince that ripens in October is aptly named on account of its hard dense texture. The ekmek or 'bread' quince that is gathered in September is a good keeper and preferred by many people because it does not have the astringent flavor of many quinces. The 'lemon' quince is another popular variety so called because of its bright yellow skin, and the esme is an eating variety widely cultivated in the Marmara region which keeps well until the end of March.











Meyco has own orchards as well as partner allied growers in Bursa region. Most popular versions of Nectarines which are grown and exported are Caldesi 2000, Big Top, Venüs and Sweet Lady varieties, in order from early to late.




























There are more than one hundred varieties of sweet cherries produced in Turkey. The 0900 Ziraat variety, also known as a Turkish Napoleon, was developed in Turkey and is the most popular variety in Turkey because it meets the characteristics demanded by export markets. However, producers have started to try new cherry varieties such as Sweet Heart, Celeste, Kordia, Regina and Sunburst for higher quality products, later harvest (to capture higher prices later in the season) and higher yields. Meyco supplies cherries from certified partner growers and serve our customers in 500gr punnets for size +24 to +26; 5 kg boxes in sizes of +28 to +30 mm; and 2 kg boxes in size 32 plus. Other packing options are available on request.









Most of this production is GGAP certified.

Consistent quality fresh produce delivery is achieved through well controlled and high technology production environment in well established green houses, some of which utilises geo-thermal energy.















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
